Facemask Use in LB Homes Care Sites

We have received further guidance from the CDC and MDH regarding Physical Contact and the use of Face Masks.

Physical distancing and source control recommendations when both the resident and all their visitors are fully vaccinated:

- While alone in the resident's room or the designated visitation room, residents and their visitors may choose to have close contact (including touch) without wearing a face mask.
- Visitors should wear face mask and physically distance from healthcare workers and other residents/visitors that are not part of their group at all times while in the facility.

Physical distancing and source control recommendations when either the resident or any of their visitors are not fully vaccinated:

- The safest approach is for everyone to maintain physical distancing and to wear a well-fitting face mask. However, if the resident is fully vaccinated, they can choose to have close contact (including touch) with their unvaccinated visitor(s) while both continue to wear well-fitting face mask.
- If the resident is not fully vaccinated, 6-foot physical distance as well as a well-fitting face mask is recommended at all times for both resident and visitor, regardless of visitor vaccination status.

Note: A well-fitting mask is required during escort to and from the visit location.

CORONAVIRUS TESTING:

Staff and residents who are fully vaccinated, no longer need to participate in testing, unless symptomatic, have a high-risk exposure, or the facility is in outbreak testing. Fully vaccinated individuals can continue to test still test if they would like to, but it will be optional during routine testing. Essential caregivers are strongly encouraged to continue testing with us however this is no longer required to be able to visit.

- This is to remind you of COVID -19 testing that is mandatory for all **unvaccinated** LB Homes Employees and recommended (but not required) for Broen Essential Caregivers on Monday, May 17th from **6:00am—9am** in Light and Life Auditorium located off Alcott Avenue (Enter through door I). - All **unvaccinated** Assisted Living Staff and recommended (but not required) for Essential Caregivers will test on Monday, May 10th from 7am-9am at the Woodland Lodge Building.
